



The new nude

Fake post-facial skin with the latest, barely there make-up formulas that leave you looking super-polished

1 Prep skin with **Estée Lauder's Idealist Pore Minimizing Skin Refinisher** – it shrinks large pores, reduces redness and evens the skin's surface, providing a perfect canvas for make-up.

2 **Lancôme's new Oscillation Powerfoundation** (currently only

available in the States but hitting British stores this spring) has a vibrating brush that buffs skin while delivering colour with a flawless, airbrushed finish. Starting from the centre of the face, work it outwards towards the jawline.

3 Gently dab the **Make Up Store's High Tech Lighter** in Stardust across cheekbones and slick across eyelids for a subtle glossy sheen.

4 For subtle brows, wipe the brush of your favourite brown mascara (we love **Artistry's Total Mascara Waterproof** in Dark Brown) until it is almost dry and then comb upwards and across from the inner brow. ▷

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5 Keep lashes simple. One coat of **L'Oréal's Studio Secrets Professional Mascara** should be enough as its rich blend of creamy waxes amplifies lashes in one go.

6 For a delicately tinted lip, use your fingers to pat **MAC's Cremeblend Blush** in Joie de Vivre across the mouth, then finish with a dab of **MAC's Cream Colour Base** in Orange Alarm at the centre of the lip for a pop of colour.
